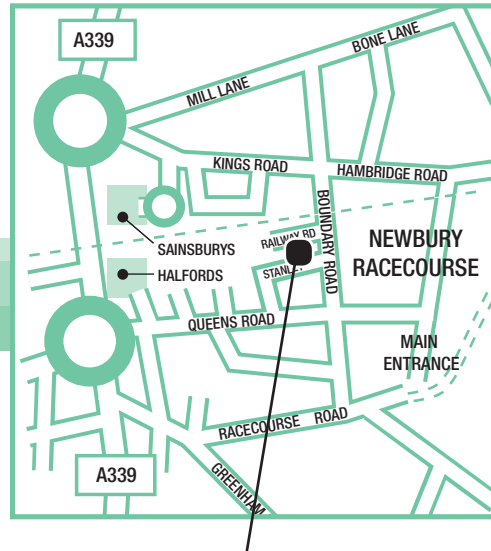

How To Find Us

By car: Going south on the A339 (old A34), with Sainsbury's on your left and Newbury Town Centre to your right, go straight across the roundabout and follow the A339. At the next roundabout, with Halfords, Burger King and Staples on the left, turn left into Queen's Road. Go to the end of Queen's Road, passing ATS garage. At the Junction with Boundary Road, turn left. Stanley Road is the first left. The practice is a red brick house at the corner. You can park in the practice car park accessed via Boundary Road or you can park on Stanley Road.

On foot: From the train station walk to the A339 dual carriageway and turn right until you get to the Halfords roundabout. There is an underpass that takes you across the A339 to Queen's Road.

Welcome to Newbury Orthodontic Centre

We would like to take the opportunity to welcome you to the practice. This leaflet contains information about the services we provide, how to make an appointment and who to contact for further information or assistance.

Your general dentist referred you, or you have requested an appointment yourself, for possible orthodontic treatment or advice here. This is a specialist practice that limits treatment to Orthodontics; your dentist provides all other dental treatment. It is essential that you continue to see your dentist for regular routine care to ensure good oral health throughout your orthodontic treatment.

Orthodontics

Orthodontics is a specialist branch of dentistry concerned with the realignment of the teeth and jaws to improve the appearance and function of the teeth and face. An attractive smile is a vital asset to personal self-confidence.

The majority of orthodontic treatment occurs when most of the adult teeth are present; usually 12-14 years. Occasionally, early treatment is indicated in the mixed dentition. However it is never too late to consider orthodontic treatment. Although adult faces are no longer growing and certain treatments cannot be achieved by braces alone, adult treatments are perfectly feasible in most instances.

Active treatment usually takes between 18 months to 2 years and most cases require fixed appliances ('train tracks') although frequently, a combination with other braces is required. After the removal of active braces, it will be necessary to wear retainers to allow the teeth to settle in their new positions. Success depends directly on patient cooperation.

NHS Treatment

Newbury Orthodontic Centre has agreed with NHS England to provide NHS Specialist Orthodontic Services to patients under the age of 18. The contract is held by Newbury Orthodontics Limited. Assessment and treatment on the NHS are available to children with a moderate to severe malocclusion. However, it may be necessary to join a waiting list before treatment can begin.

Private Treatment

As well as providing NHS orthodontic services for NHS England, we also provide private treatment to all adults and those children whose malocclusion is too mild to qualify for NHS treatment. In addition, tooth coloured ceramic appliances, transparent aligners and invisible Lingual (inside) appliances are available by private contract.

Please ask for details if you are interested in any of these treatments. Under the current regulations, it is not possible to mix private appliances and NHS treatment.

For private treatment, you will be provided with a written treatment proposal and quotation after detailed records are taken and assessed. A monthly standing order payment option is available. Please feel free to ask for details.

First Appointment

Once referred by your dentist, we will try to offer you an appointment as soon as possible at a convenient time. Please call 01635 528830 to make an appointment. You are free to choose which orthodontist in the practice you would like to see providing that appointments are available. Once active treatment has started, you are strongly advised not to transfer to another orthodontist mid-treatment. Your first appointment is for an initial assessment only. Children under the age of 16 must be accompanied by their parent or guardian. For children, the initial assessment is free of charge. At the appointment, you will be asked to fill in a medical questionnaire. It may be necessary to take some radiographs (x-ray) to complete the assessment.

After a thorough examination, it should be possible for the orthodontist to advise you if you would benefit from having treatment, if you qualify for

NHS treatment, if you are ready for treatment and if so, an outline about possible treatment options. However, a detailed treatment plan will not be available until further records are taken and assessed. You are free to decide if you would like to proceed with the treatment proposed.

Appointments & Cancellations

We try our best to see all patients on time. To achieve this, we rely on all our patients to arrive on time. We are very grateful for your cooperation to enable the practice to run smoothly. If you have to cancel an appointment, we would appreciate 24 hours' notice so that someone else may take up the slot.

Urgent Treatment and Out of Hours Care

Patients undergoing active treatment with our practice will be seen for brace related problems. If you have a problem, please ring 01635 528830 during surgery hours for advice or an appointment. If you are in pain outside surgery hours, please contact NHS 111.

Your Orthodontic Records

Your orthodontic records will remain confidential and secure. However from time to time we may be asked to release these to the NHS as part of our ongoing clinical review process. We will try to contact you before releasing your records to another organisation. We are committed to upholding the Data Protection Act 1998 and Freedom of Information Act 2003.

Standards and Facilities

We are committed to the highest clinical standards and all clinical staff undertake lifelong continuous professional development to keep up-to-date. The practice complies with national standards in Health and Safety, sterilisation and disinfection, use of x-ray equipment and complaints procedure. The practice is on the ground floor with wheelchair access (maximum width 74cm) to the reception, waiting room and one of the two surgeries. We look forward to seeing you in the practice.
